Welcome to **The Grund Operations Manual** for **Warhammer Age of Sigmar: Soulbound**. This supplement includes detailed information on the Arkonaut Ironclad *The Grund*, giving you everything you need to turn the venerable airship and her stalwart crew into a key feature of your **Soulbound** campaign.

Included within is detailed information on the airship itself and what exactly an Arkonaut Ironclad can do. This includes a detailed map of the airship and a statblock to let you take her into battle, should the clouds of the Mortal Realms prove as dangerous as the Kharadron mutter. *The Grund's* crew is also covered, with a thorough **Crew Manifest** highlighting each of the unique characters who call its metal hull their home and providing statblocks to represent them.

Once you are familiar with the capabilities of the airship and her crew, you can seek out a sky-port's ransom worth of unique **Weapons and Endrinworks** to improve *The Grund's* performance. Some of these even unlock new capabilities or methods of generating revenue between adventures.

With the ship and crew ready to launch, you can take to the skies with an exciting assortment of random encounters for GMs to use to make journeys more memorable, and a number of Endeavours players can undertake to keep the ship occupied — and hopefully profitable — during their downtime periods.

So stow your rig and step up to the wheel, captain. *The Grund* is preparing to depart.
